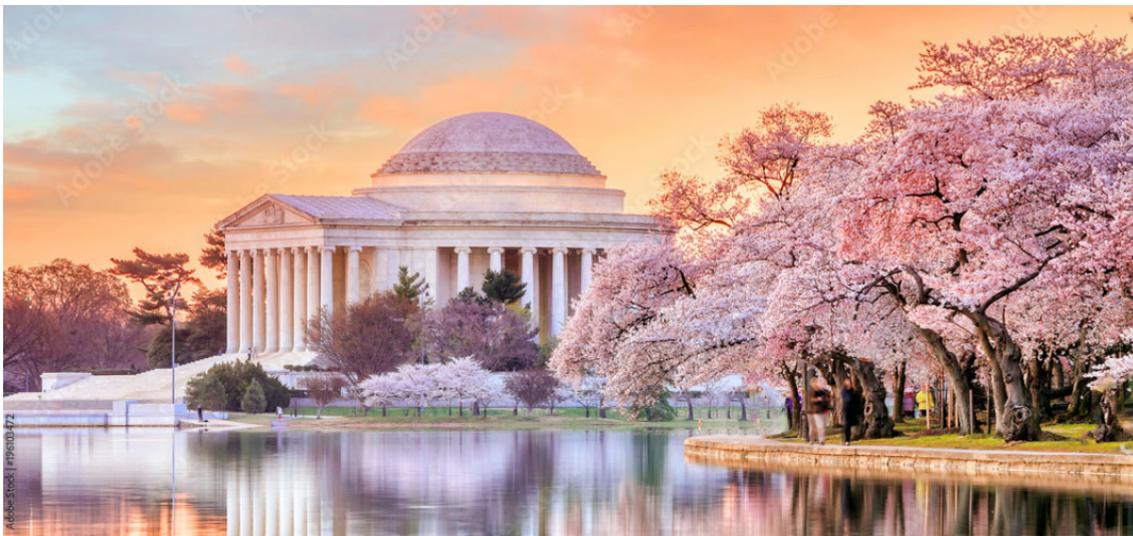

Where we will be: The National Academies building is directly on the National Mall, which is a landscaped park near Washington, D.C.'s downtown area. It contains and borders several museums of the Smithsonian Institution, art galleries, cultural institutions, and various memorials, sculptures, and statues. Its core area extends between the United States Capitol grounds to the east and the Washington Monument to the west and is lined to the north and south by several museums and a federal office building.
